To all of our valued CFG clients:

We hope that everyone has managed to stay healthy, safe, and prosperous despite the continuing disruptions caused by the global pandemic. The past two tax seasons provided unprecedented challenges for everyone. We hope to have a more normalized tax filing season this year. Even though we continue to operate in a virtual environment, we know that circumstances can change rapidly. We want to assure you that we are prepared to meet the challenges that may arise.

Last year we introduced *SafeSend Returns* as our electronic delivery method of tax returns. *SafeSend Returns* allowed us to automate the delivery, review, and signature of your federal and state income tax returns from the convenience of your computer, smartphone, or tablet. It is user-friendly, highly secure and an easier way for you to manage your tax returns. We received a lot of positive feedback on this new system, and will continue to utilize it this year.

In 2021 many clients took advantage of the new option to pay their tax preparation invoice via credit card or e-check directly through *SafeSend Returns* (or through the "Make Payment" link on our website www.corradofg.com). We are notified automatically when you upload your signed forms and/or make a payment using *SafeSend Returns*, or when you make a payment through our website. Payment of the tax preparation fee is required prior to e-filing your returns.

This year's federal individual tax filing deadline, along with most states, is currently **Monday, April 18, 2022**. Your tax returns will be prepared for e-filing automatically, at no additional fee. In order to facilitate this process, the majority of client returns will be delivered electronically using *SafeSend Returns*. All forms that require your signature will be included, and *SafeSend Returns* will walk you through the process of electronically signing and submitting the forms to us. Once we receive your signed forms and payment for the tax preparation fee, we will e-file your tax returns. (We will continue to send forms via U.S. Mail for clients who are unable to utilize electronic delivery.)

Other items to note regarding tax return e-filing:

1. **You should be aware that the IRS is experiencing severe problems and delays processing checks, paperwork, and other correspondence.** We strongly recommend that you provide us with banking information before your tax return is delivered via *SafeSend Returns* so that we may arrange to have any refunds directly deposited in your bank account and/or the funds withdrawn from your account for any balances due on April 18th. Please note that the withdrawals will **not** occur before April 18th **even if we e-file your returns prior to that date.**
2. If you still prefer to pay your tax balance due or receive your refund by check, we request that you please let us know prior to delivery of your return via *SafeSend Returns*, so that vouchers for payment may be included and we can remove any old banking information, if applicable.
3. When we have received both your signed forms and your payment for the tax preparation fee, we will e-file your returns. Unless you hear otherwise from us, you should consider your e-filing complete.



4. The copy of your tax returns that you receive through *SafeSend Returns* is your final copy. Electronic copies can be accessed through *SafeSend Returns* for the next two years. Within *SafeSend Returns* you have the option to download, save, and print a copy of your tax returns. We will send a paper copy of your tax returns **upon request only**.
5. We will retain copies of e-filing acceptance notices from the various tax authorities. We will send you copies of these e-filing acceptance notices **upon request only**.

REMINDERS

Please submit copies of your tax documents as soon as possible so that we may begin preparing your returns. Please do not wait to send your documents if you are missing only 1 or 2 items. These can be sent to us when you receive them. Given the constraints of the ongoing pandemic, in-person client meetings will be very limited. We encourage you to submit your tax documents electronically using SafeSend Exchange or your CFG client portal. Please **do not** send electronic documents as regular email attachments. If you send hard copies, use a traceable method such as Priority/Express Mail, UPS, or FedEx. Please **do not** send us your original tax documents. If you think that a follow-up call will be necessary, please let us know. We will contact you to schedule the call after we receive your documents.

We will continue to use CFG client portals to coordinate the flow of source tax documents during tax season. They may also be used to exchange other sensitive documents (such as wills, trusts, life and/or disability insurance policies, etc.) with us throughout the year. If you already have a client portal, you may access it 24/7 through our website (www.corradofg.com) by clicking the 3 horizontal lines at upper righthand corner of the screen and selecting "Login," or you can go directly to the portal login at this web address: www.clientaccess.com/#/login. If you do not yet have a CFG client portal, and would like us to create one for you, please contact Kim Floyd (kfloyd@corradofg.com) to request one. For clients who choose not to have a portal, we will continue utilizing SafeSend Exchange to securely exchange sensitive documents via email.
